Board Discussion:

League By-Laws – Discussion on player weights. Coaches want to weigh eligible “by design” ball carriers that weigh 145 lb. to 155 lb. ball carriers every Saturday, as well as any player weighing 170 lbs

up to 185 lbs. Discussed having a hard line at 185 lbs. If a player weighs in at 185 lbs. they will not be allowed to play that day. Recommending if a player weighs in over 145 lbs. and will play as an eligible position by design, they will weigh in on game days.

Action for all: Come in with “hand in dirt” definition and rules in the next meeting (May 10th).

Pants – Milestones match dollars. Process to obtain pants will be decided.
